O R D E R

In this application the Department of Public Works of the State of California requests authority to abolish, by removal of the track, an existing crossing of State Highway Route 106 with a line of railroad owned and operated by the United States Navy near Clyde, Contra Costa County. The United States Navy has constructed new trackage which crosses State Highway Route 106 at separated grades and has informed the Commission that it has no objections to the removal of the existing grade crossing; therefore,

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to abolish, by removal of the track, that certain grade crossing, formerly identified in the Commission's records as Crossing No. 14-3.0 of track owned by the United States Navy with State Highway Route 106, in the vicinity of Clyde, Contra Costa County.

Within thirty days after abandonment as authorized in this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall lapse if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
