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## Decision No. 42997

In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works for an order authorizing the construction of a crossing at grade of State Highway, Route 3, and the tracks of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company, and to close existing Crossing No. C-124.8 at Sheridan, Placer County, State of California.

## <u>order</u>

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to reconstruct State Highway Route 3 at grade across the main line track of Southern Pacific Company near Sheridan, Placer County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. C-124.8. Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with agreement between the applicant and Southern Pacific Company. Should the parties fail to agree the Commission will apportion such costs by further order. Width of crossing shall be not less than 48 feet and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No.72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G.O. No.75-B) and by existing overhead neon signs which may be relocated.

Upon completion existing Crossing No. C=124.8 about 200 feet southerly shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall lapse if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so

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require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
