In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to reclassify its Class "C" Non-Agency Station at Stanford in the County of Placer, State of California, to a Class "E" Station, and to cancel all tariffs to and from said Stanford Station.

ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Stanford during the past two years and that continued maintenance thereof as a freight station is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to re-classify its non-agency station of Stanford, County of Placer, to a Class "E" station at which freight will not be handled; to change its station records accordingly; and to cancel all freight tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall lapse if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
