SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 42887, dated May 17, 1949, in the above-entitled application authorized the construction of a spur track crossing in the City of Oakland with the usual provision that the order be effective twenty days from its date. By amendment to application filed on May 13, 1949, applicant has requested that the authority be made effective immediately due to the fact that the industry to be served by the spur track has been forced to vacate its present site in San Francisco and desires to take delivery of rail shipments at its Oakland plant as soon as possible.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 42887 is modified to provide that the authority therein granted become effective on the date hereof.

In all other respects said decision is in full force and effect.
