

Twelve of the applicants hereinabove listed⁽¹⁾ have jointly filed a petition for an extension of time in which to comply with Paragraph 4 (b) of Decision 42623, which is the paragraph for filing of tariffs, as hereinabove set out. The extension of time is requested for all parties, in the interests of uniformity. Specifically, the petition requests an additional seventy-five (75) days, and alleges that this time is necessary because of the great amount of data which must be compiled in order to effectively prepare tariff publications, and because of the large number of origin and destination points which must be included in these tariff publications. Also, it is alleged that the publishing of this tariff will entail the obtaining of authority for departing from the provisions of Section 24 of the Public Utilities Act.

In view of the allegations made in this petition, and in view of the original record made in this matter, which discloses an extremely large number of origin and destination points, many of which are not on the present constructive mileage maps, and are not contained in the Constructive Mileage Table 3, it is our opinion that this extension of time is in the public interest, and, accordingly, it will be granted.

ORDER

A petition having been filed in the above-entitled matters, requesting an extension of seventy-five (75) days in which to comply with the provisions of Paragraph 4 (b) of Decision 42623, dated March 15, 1949, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Paragraph 4 (b) of Decision 42623 be amended to read as follows:

- (b) Applicants shall, within one hundred thirty-five (135) days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, establish the service herein authorized and comply with the provisions of General Order 80 and Part IV of General Order 93-A, by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this Order shall be one (1) day after the date hereof.
