OPINION AND ORDER

Hilarita Silberberg, operating under the fictitious firm name of Tiburon Water Works, requests permission to abandon public utility water service in and about the town of Tiburon, in Marin County. She alleges that the system has had no customers for several years last past and that all former customers of said Tiburon Water Works are now being served by the Marin Municipal Water District.

This system originally was installed prior to 1912 by Hugh A. Boyle, father of applicant. A field investigation shows that no customers are now being served with water from this system, nor have there been any customers served for two or more years last past. Marin Municipal Water District, a public corporation, now supplies water to all former customers of Tiburon Water Works.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that it is not a matter on which a public hearing is necessary, and that the request should be granted; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Hilarita Silberberg, operating in and in the vicinity of the town of Tiburon in the County of Marin, under the fictitious firm name and style of Tiburon Water Works, be and she is hereby authorized to discontinue all public utility water

service as of the effective date of this order and thereupon and thereafter stand relieved of all public utility obligations and liabilities in connection therewith.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
