ORDER

Crescent City Water Company, a corporation, engaged in the business of operating a water system in and in the vicinity of Crescent City, Del Norte County, asks the Commission for authority to sell certain of its real property to Crescent City Gas Company, a corporation.

Applicant reports that the property to be transferred consists of a parcel of land, 90 feet by 119 feet, located in Crescent City, said property being non-operative and not necessary to applicant in the operation of the water system. The consideration to be paid for the property is \$500 in cash.

It appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Crescent City Water Company, a corporation, is authorized to sell, after the effective date hereof and on or before October 31, 1949, to Crescent City Gas Company, a corporation, the real property hereinabove referred to and more particularly described in the application, in accordance with the terms of a grant deed, a copy of which is attached to the application and marked Exhibit "A" subject to the following conditions:

1. Crescent City Water Company shall, on or before October 31, 1949, notify the Commission in writing of the completion of the property transfer herein authorized, and shall file with

this Commission a true copy of the final instrument of conveyance within twenty (20) days after said transfer;

2. The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of the property herein authorized to be transferred.

The authority herein granted shall be effective upon the date hereof.
