ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional spur track at grade across Fifth Street in Crows Landing, Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BA-113.2. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall lapse if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the spur track is required to handle inbound shipments of shoo in preparation for packing the forthcoming melon crop and requests that this authority be made effective on its date for this reason.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
