FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 42040 of September 14, 1948, in this proceeding, revoked various Emergency Transportation Resolutions promulgated during World War II. It continued in effect Resolution No. 12 dealing with the diversion of shipments by common carriers in compliance with General Order No. 1 of the Office of Defense Transportation and with tariff provisions relating to such shipments. That General Order having been canceled effective June 30, 1949, Resolution No. 12 should concurrently be revoked. The carriers will be authorized and directed to cancel the tariff provisions involved.

A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Emergency Resolution No. 12 be and it is hereby revoked.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that common carriers be and they are hereby authorized and directed to cancel tariff provisions

published in compliance with Emergency Resolution No. 12 within sixty (60) days after the effective date of this order and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The effective date of this order shall be June 30, 1949.
