ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct spur tracks at grade across portions of Jennings Street and Carroll, Donner and Egbert Avenues in San Francisco, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

Carroll Ave. near Jennings St.	as	Crossing	No.	E-4.18-C
Jennings St. near Carroll Ave.	"	"	"	E-4.22-C
Opposite Donner Ave.	"	"	"	E-4.25-C
Jennings St. near Egbert Ave.	"	"	"	E-4.27-C
Egbert Ave. near Jennings St.	"	"	"	E-4.30-C
Egbert Ave. east of Keith St.	"	"	"	E-4.35-C

Construction of each of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue or street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B) at each location. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Certified Copy of Permit from the City and County shall be filed with the Commission prior to beginning construction.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall lapse if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
