O P I N I O N

D. Moyer, doing business as Moyers Stages, is presently conducting a passenger stage service between Fresno and Parlier via Sanger. In this proceeding he requests authority to discontinue the operation between Sanger and Parlier and intermediate points. The operative right involved was created by Decision No. 31342 and amended by Decision No. 31455 in Application No. 22059. Applicant Moyer acquired the operative right pursuant to authority issued in Decision No. 34154 in Application No. 24066.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges, in substance, that the public demand for that service is insufficient to warrant its further operation, and that Pacific Greyhound Lines by operating five daily schedules between Parlier and Fresno adequately serves the points involved.

After full consideration the request of applicant does not appear to be adverse to the public interest and will be authorized subject to the posting of an appropriate public notice. No public hearing is necessary.

O R D E R

An application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED,

(1) That D. Moyer may discontinue passenger stage operations between Sanger and Parlier and intermediate points, on or after the effective date hereof, provided that a minimum of five days' notice to the public of discontinuance of that service be made by posting said notice in all vehicles operating between Sanger and Parlier.

(2) That appropriate supplements to effective tariffs and time tables, be filed in triplicate with the Commission cancelling all applicable fares, rates and time schedules, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

(3) That the operative right created by Decision No. 31342 as amended by Decision No. 31455 is hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be ~~25~~¹⁰ days after the date hereof.
