O P I N I O N

Under date of March 15, 1949, the Commission issued Decision No. 42623 in the above-entitled application. This decision provided that the applicant should comply with the provisions of General Order No. 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission within 60 days from the effective date of the order, and upon not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and to the public. The order became effective on April 4, 1949, 20 days after its date. The sixty-day period for filing tariffs would have expired on June 3, 1949.

Petitioner herein requests an extension of time in which to comply with Paragraph (4)(b) of Decision No. 42623, which is the paragraph for filing of tariffs as hereinabove set out. This extension of time is requested because of the difficulties involved in compiling a satisfactory tariff publication.

By Decision No. 42953, dated June 1, 1949, on Applications Nos. 29416, et al, the Commission granted an extension of time for all 35 applicants concerned in Decision No. 42623. The instant

applicant was one of those covered by Decision No. 42953, and, therefore, this petition becomes unnecessary and accordingly will be denied.

O R D E R

A petition having been filed in the above-entitled matter, the Commission having considered the same, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition be and it hereby is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
