In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of Califormia, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing) Application No. 30274 the installation of crossings at grade of the Access Roads to Huntington Beach State Park and tracks of the Pacific Electric Railway (Newport Beach Line) in the vicinity of Huntington Beach State Park, Orange County, State of California.

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct Hampshire Avenue and Bushard Street at grade across the Newport Beach line of Pacific Electric Railway Company in the County of Orange, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 6E-33.42 and 6E-35.07, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two (2) feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing at Hampshire Avenue shall be not less than twenty-two (22) feet and at Bushard Street not less than forty (40) feet, with grades of approach not greater than six (6) per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection at each location shall be by two (2) Standard No. & flashing light signals, G.O. 75-B. Traffic signals at the intersection of Hampshire Avenue and Pacific Coast Highway shall be so interconnected with the flashing light

signals at Crossing No. 62-33.42 as to eliminate the possibility of conflicting indications between the two systems.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advice the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied. with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be gwenty (20) days after the date hereof.
