O P I N I O N

At the hearing in the above-entitled matters on June 13 and 14, 1949, thirty (30) exhibits were presented by the Special Crime Study Commission on organized crime of the State of California. Of these exhibits which related to alleged bookmaking activities Nos. 1 to 3 inclusive; 6 to 13 inclusive; 15 to 21 inclusive; 25 to 30 inclusive, were original documents, while Exhibits 4, 5, 14, 22, 23 and 24 were copies. The Special Crime Study Commission has now requested permission to substitute photostatic copies for the exhibits which are original documents. This request is made in order that these original documents may be used for other work of the Special Crime Study Commission. This request appearing in the public interest will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED That the Special Crime Study Commission on organized crime of the State of California be permitted to withdraw the original documents submitted in this Case as Exhibit 1 to 3 inclusive; 6 to 13 inclusive; 15 to 21 inclusive and 25 to 30 inclusive and that photostatic copies of those exhibits be substituted therefor.
