SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Southern Pacific Company and Pacific Motor Trucking Company seek authority to change the boundaries of their pickup and delivery zones at Salinas. The proposed zones would include substantially all of the area within the present zones and certain additional territory. Salinas rates are proposed to be applied throughout the modified zones.

The verified petition, as amended, shows that the additional territory is within 3 miles of the corporate limits of the city; that, during the past 12 months, pickup and delivery service has not been performed in the areas in which the service is proposed to be withdrawn; and that there is little or no prospect of any demand for service in those areas.

Competing carriers were notified of the filing of the petition. No objection has been offered to its being granted.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the granting of the sought authority is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petitioners be and they are hereby authorized to change their pickup and delivery zones at Salinas as requested, and to establish for the transportation involved, within sixty (60) days after the effective date of this order, and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, rates not less than those prescribed for like transportation to and from Salinas.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date of this order.
