O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a connecting track between its Monrovia line and its Duarte Branch, at grade, across Mountain Avenue (State Road VII-LA-9-MNro) and Royal Oaks Avenue (formerly Duarte Avenue) in the City of Monrovia, Los Angeles County, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 6B-18.53-C and 6B-18.57-C. respectively. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72, without super-elevation, and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding five and one-half (5½) per cent at Mountain Avenue and three (3) per cent at Royal Oaks Avenue. Protection at each location shall be by two (2) Standard No. 8 flashing light signals, G.O. 75-B.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall lapse if not exercised within one (1) year,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Nothing herein authorized shall be construed as a commitment by the Commission on any of the issues involved in Application No. 30095.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
