O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across a portion of Laurel Street in Washington Township in the vicinity of Newark, Alameda County, at the location described in the application.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that Laurel Street is not at present open to public use and travel and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall lapse if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
