ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing that Decision No. 40038, of March 4, 1947 (as amended by Decision No. 40211, of April 29, 1947), in Application No. 28055, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Julius E. Nervo, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 2-1/4 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers between Santa Rosa and Sonoma County Airport and intermediate points as more specifically defined and restricted therein; and it further appearing from recent investigations by the Commission's staff that none of the transportation services authorized has ever been performed by applicant, no Annual Reports filed, no suspensions of service either requested or granted; that on January 19, 1949, applicant advised the Commission that no vehicle miles had been performed during the calendar year 1948; and that, by letter dated June 19, 1949, applicant advised the Commission relative to this authorization, in part as follows:

"I did receive a franchise to operate regular bus service but did not use the privilege account of not being able to secure proper insurance . . . I had a bus all set for the regular bus service [for] which I have filed a tariff, but as I said before this service was never used."

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS FOUND that the said Julius E. Nervo has not been and is not now conducting the passenger stage transportation services hereinbefore referred to and that no application for the suspension of any operations under said operative right has been made, and none has been granted, thereby resulting in abandonment of said operative right.

IT IS ORDERED that the above mentioned entire operative right of Julius E. Nervo, to, from, or between the several points and places aforesaid, be and the same is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and time tables on file with this Commission are hereby cancelled and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof in the manner provided by law, unless the said Julius E. Nervo, before such effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order, denying the statements set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until hearing is had and further order is issued.
