O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct at grade an extension of siding across State Highway No. 88 (Main Street) in the vicinity of Grimes, County of Colusa, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. AJ-120.6. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superlevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 3 per cent. Protection of the entire crossing shall be by two reflectorized Standard No. 14 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry to be served needs an early determination in this matter, therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
