FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pursuant to the authority granted by Decision No. 42531, dated February 23, 1949, Blythe Gas Co., Ltd. on February 28, 1949, transferred its properties to Southern California Gas Company. The Uniform System of Accounts for Gas Corporations, effective January 1, 1949, requires Southern California Gas Company to file with the Commission, within six months from the date of the acquisition of said properties, its proposed journal entries to distribute the cost of such properties to the appropriate primary and other accounts.

Southern California Gas Company reports that it discovered recently records of Blythe Gas Co., Ltd. and its predecessors which it desires to examine before submitting said journal entries. It therefore asks the Commission to extend the time for the filing of said journal entries to September 28, 1949.

The Commission has considered applicant's request and is of the opinion that such request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company shall file with the Commission, on or before September 28, 1949, its proposed journal entries to distribute to the appropriate primary and other accounts the cost of acquiring the properties of Blythe Gas Co., Ltd.

The authority herein granted is effective upon the date hereof.
