O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct three industrial spur tracks at grade across Harrison Street between Alameda and 13th Streets, in the City and County of San Francisco, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-2.41-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Applicant may deviate from the provisions of General Order No. 26-D and establish side clearances as shown on the map attached to the application.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Industry to be served is desirous of having immediate use of said tracks, therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
