ORDER VACATING ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

By orders dated February 28 and April 12, 1949, in the above-entitled proceeding, the Commission suspended, until September 30, 1949, the expiration of Rule 51 of Supplements Nos. 8 and 11 to Western Classification No. 73, Cal.P.U.C.-W.C. No. 6. This action was taken following receipt of protests from shippers alleging, among other things, that expiration of the transit privileges authorized by that rule would be detrimental to their interests. Permission to establish a new rule containing substantially the same privileges has since been obtained.<sup>1</sup> This rule has been filed to become effective September 30, 1949. The cause for suspension having thus been removed our orders of February 28 and April 12, 1949, should be vacated and this proceeding discontinued.
