ORDER

In this application Sacramento City Lines requests permission to discontinue operation of its motor coach service along 3rd Street between "I" and "K" Streets along "K" Street between 3rd and 4th Streets, and along "J" Street between 3rd and 4th Streets in the City of Sacramento.

By its Decision No. 39748, dated December 16, 1946, the Commission authorized applicant to operate motor coaches over the routes above enumerated, along with other services.

Applicant alleges that at the westerly end of Southern Pacific Company's depot parking lot the City of Sacramento has placed a barrier to prevent traffic from entering "I" and 3rd Streets at this point; that prior to the time the barrier was placed at this point, applicant entered 3rd Street from the grounds of Southern Pacific Company and continued to "J" and "K" Streets; that applicant has been operating its coaches over 4th Street between Southern Pacific Company's grounds and "K" Street and along Southern Pacific Company's grounds since the barrier was erected, and that it was authorized by this Commission's

Decision No. 39748 to operate along said 4th Street and said Southern Pacific Company's grounds.

It appears that applicant can no longer operate over the routes first above mentioned and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Sacramento City Lines is authorized to discontinue operating motor coach service along 3rd Street between "I" and "K" Streets, along "K" Street between 3rd and 4th Streets, and along "J" Street between 3rd and 4th Streets, in the City of Sacramento.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
