ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one additional track at grade across Jones Street between North Point and Beach Streets in San Francisco, at the location described in the application. Said track will be operated by the State Belt Railway and no crossing number is assigned. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by existing crossing signs. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall lapse if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
