In the matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the widening and reconstruction of existing grade crossings of State Highway, Route and the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company south of Watsonville, County of Monterey, State of California.

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to reconstruct two crossings at grade of State Highway Route 56 with branch line tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Watsonville Junction, Monterey County, at the locations described in the application and identified as Crossings No. EC-100.6 and No. EC-100.7-C. Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with agreement between the parties. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be substantially as shown on plan attached to the application and grades of approach shall be not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by existing standard crossing signals which may be moved to suitable locations.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
