The City of Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, is authorized to construct an extension of Spencer Street to connect with 17th Street at grade across an industrial lead track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company in that city, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 5-56.1-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protoction shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G.O. No. 75-B).

Before constructing said crossing applicant shall take all legal steps required to vacate as a public street that portion of 17th Street now crossing the right of way of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, about 200 fect northerly from the crossing herein authorized. Evidence of such action shall be filed with the Commission.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be

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extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant desires to complete construction of said crossing in advance of the rainy season and has requested that this authority be made effective at once. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
