O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate a spur track at grade across the intersection of "R" and 22nd Streets (Crossing No. AH-91.3) and to relocate a spur track across a portion of "R" Street near 23rd Street in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the locations described in the application. Said relocation will result in one less track across 23rd Street. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-  
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or  
safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after  
the date hereof.
