O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Bieghle Street in Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-1120.7-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry to be served requires early construction of the crossing and applicant has requested that the authority if granted

be made effective immediately. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
