ORDER

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Largo for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof as a Class B Station is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Largo, County of Mendocino, from Class B, a station at which freight in carload lots will be received or delivered, to Class E, a station at which freight will not be handled; to change its station records accordingly; and to cancel all freight tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after reclassification as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
