In the matter of the application of the City of Sacramento for the establishment of a pedestrian crossing at grade over the tracks of the Central California Traction Company near 58th Street.

ORDER

The City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at grade with the main track of Central California Traction Company near 58th Street in that city, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 61-46.2-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Central California Traction Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not greater than eight feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G. O. No. 75-B). A turnstile shall be installed and maintained at expense of applicant, at the right-of-way fence.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
