O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and Southern Pacific Company are authorized to construct a spur track at grade across a portion of Eighth Street in Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application. Applicants shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that Eighth Street is not at present open to public use and travel at the point of crossing and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicants shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicants request that the usual twenty day waiting period be waived so that they may immediately construct the spur track and serve the industry named.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
