In this proceeding, Ernest E. Stubblefield seeks a license to engage in business as a motor transportation broker pursuant to Statutes 1935, Chapter 705. Evidence in support of the application was received at a public hearing before Examiner Paul at Los Angeles on October 28, 1949, and the matter was submitted.

Applicant resides at 5738 Harcourt Avenue, Los Angeles, California, which is to be temporarily used at his place of business. The operation proposed is that of a brokerage and dispatching service for the transportation of general commodities between Los Angeles and other points in that area. Applicant plans to execute agreements with various carriers providing for compensation upon a percentage basis of approximately 7 per cent. Business will be solicited only for carriers who have proper operating authority from the Commission and from whom applicant has received a letter of authority designating him as their transportation representative.

Applicant stated that at the present time he is unemployed. During the period from 1939 to 1942 he was engaged in the trucking business. Since then he has at various times been employed in various construction work in different parts of

Southern California. He stated that no billing or collection services will be performed for the carriers for whom he will act as broker. Records of all transactions will be maintained. The required bond has been filed.

We believe that the evidence shows applicant to be qualified to act as a motor transportation broker. The application will therefore be granted.

<u>ORDER</u>

A public hearing having been held in the above entitled proceeding, the matter having been duly submitted and the Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that the application of Ernest E. Stubblefield for a license as a motor transportation broker, as defined in Chapter 705, Statutes of 1935, be and it hereby is granted, and that such license be issued to said Ernest E. Stubblefield subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That said licensee shall keep his license certificate as a motor transportation broker open at all times to public inspection.
- 2. That said licensee shall do business as a motor transportation broker only at 5738 Harcourt Avenue, Los Angeles 43, California, and for the motor carriers hereinafter named, or for whom he may hereafter from time to time be permitted to do business by any subsequent order or orders of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the license of said applicant shall authorize him to sell, offer for sale, negotiate for, furnish, or provide and hold himself out to sell, negotiate for, furnish, or provide transportation of property over the public highways of this State to be furnished only by the carriers whose names, addresses,
