OPINION AND ORDER

Paul L. Carder operates a public utility warehouse at Oswald, Sutter County. By this application he seeks authority to lease the warehouse property and equipment to Ed J. Lyng, Sarah C. Lyng and Richard Lyng, copartners, for a two-year period.

The verified application shows that Carder desires to withdraw from the warehouse business in order to devote his full time to his trucking operations, and that the Lyngs have operated public warehouses for many years. No change is proposed in the service available to the public or in the rates and charges therefor.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paul L. Carder may, within sixty (60) days after the effective date of this order, lease the warehouse property and equipment involved in this proceeding to Ed J. Lyng, Sarah C. Lyng and Richard Lyng, copartners, for a two-year period, as requested; that, prior to the effective date of said lease, Paul L. Carder and Ed J. Lyng, Sarah C. Lyng and Richard Lyng shall, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, supplement or reissue tariffs on file with the Commission, in so far

as they name rates, rules and regulations governing warehouse operations of Carder at Oswald, Sutter County, to show that he has withdrawn and canceled and that the Lyngs have concurrently adopted or established as their own said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
