FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 43272 in this application, the Commission authorized the construction of a side track at grade across State Highway #88 in the vicinity of Grimes, Colusa County, and said decision provided that the crossing be protected by two reflectorized Standard No. 1A crossing signs.

Applicant and the Division of Highways have now agreed to install floodlights at this crossing, the cost to be shared equally. Since it appears that such protection is superior to that required by the Commission's order, a modification of Decision No. 43272 is desirable; therefore

Good Cause Appearing IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 43272 is hereby modified to provide that Crossing No. AJ-120.6 shall be protected by two floodlights and two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

In all other respects Decision No. 43272 is in full force and effect.
