ORDER OF REVOCATION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS

The Commission by Decision No. 39129, in Application No. 27469, granted to Charles A. Christenson and John T. Smith a certificate to provide passenger stage service between Rodeo and adjacent communities and intermediate points. Decision No. 41953, dated August 17, 1948, in Application No. 29428, authorized the suspension of that service until September 1, 1949, and provided that said operative right should be relinquished if service thereunder is not reestablished on or prior to September 1, 1949..

In this proceeding, the Commission is petitioned to revoke that certificate based upon the fact that said service has not been reestablished. Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by Charles A. Christenson and John T. Smith pursuant to the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 39129, in Application No. 27469, is hereby revoked and annulled.

(2) That all effective tariffs and time tables on file with the Commission in the name of Charles A. Christenson and John T. Smith are hereby cancelled as of the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
