SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

By Decision No. 43527, dated November 15, 1949, in this proceeding, the Commission found that respondent handled certain C. O. D. shipments in violation of the Highway Carriers' Act. In doing so, the section of the Act violated was, through inadvertence, stated as being 15-5/8 instead of Section No. 13-5/8.

The first sentence appearing in the last paragraph of the opinion in Decision No. 43527 is, therefore, amended to read as follows:

"We find that in handling each of the 20 C. O. D. shipments referred to in the record herein respondent
violated Section No. 13-5/8 of the Highway Carriers' Act
in that he failed to observe orders of the Commission by
accepting the shipments without having at any time on
file a C. O. D. bond, as required by General Order No. 84-B,
and in several instances by not seasonably remitting C. O. D.
moneys."
