SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 43460 of October 25, 1949, in these proceedings, established revised rates and charges for pool car operations within the East Bay drayage area. Commodity rates on furniture and furniture parts (Item No. 830-B of City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A) were included in this adjustment. In revising the tariff item, a restriction excluding pool car distribution from the application of certain of these rates was not eliminated as contemplated under the adjustment. The tariff will be further amended accordingly.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 41362, as amended, in these proceedings) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 3, 1950, Third Revised Page 36 cancels Second Revised Page 36 attached hereto and by

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this reference made a part hereof; and that any tariff publications of common carrier respondents in Case No. 4109 filed pursuant to this order may be made effective not earlier than January 3, 1950, and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

In all other respects the aforesaid Decision No. 41362, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
