FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Prior orders in this proceeding have authorized applicant to deviate from the minimum rates applicable to the transportation of iron and steel structural materials and babbitt metal for Joseph T. Ryerson & Son, Inc. between its Los Angeles County plant and points in Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego Counties. The authority is scheduled to expire January 1, 1950. Permission thereafter to deviate from the established minimum rates and to observe the present rates for a ninety-day period is now sought. The limited extension was granted pending consideration of applicant's request to deviate from the minimum rates for a one-year period and to extend the authority to include San Bernardino, Riverside, Ventura and Kern Counties. These proposals have been set for hearing on January 10, 1950.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the granting of the further limited extension of time here sought is justified. The order will be made effective January 1, 1950, so that there will be no lapse in applicant's present authority.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of Decision No. 40388, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to April 1, 1950, unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective January 1, 1950.
