ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On July 21, 1949, Julian R. Wagy, Administrator of the Estate of J. I. Wagy, filed an application asking for an increase in the rates of West Side Water Company, operating in and about the City of Maricopa, Kern County.

Thereafter, on December 8, 1949, said Julian R. Wagy, as Administrator of the Estate of J. I. Wagy, together with Western Water Company, a public utility water corporation serving an extensive area in and about the City of Taft in Kern County, jointly filed Application No. 30434 asking for permission to transfer the domestic water system to Western Water Company. Concurrently, the City of Maricopa joined with said Julian R. Wagy, as Administrator, in Application No. 30835 requesting authorization of the sale of the West Side Water Company's fire system to said city.

Both of these transfers have been authorized this day by Decisions No. 42646 and No. 42647, and Western Water Company will continue the present rates in effect. It appears, therefore, that the application for a rate increase now should be dismissed. Now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this proceeding as above entitled be and it is dismissed.
