## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On July 26, 1949, in response to numerous informal complaints against the West Side Water Company, this Commission instituted an investigation on its own motion into all of the various phases of this utility's operations.

Before this detailed investigation had been completed, Julian R. Wagy, Administrator of the Estate of J. I. Wagy, together with Western Water Company, a public utility water corporation serving an extensive area in and about the City of Taft, in Kern County, jointly filed Application No. 30834, requesting permission to transfer the domestic water system to Western Water Company. Concurrently the City of Maricopa joined with said Julian R. Wagy as Administrator in Application No. 30835, asking for authorization of the sale of West Side Water Company's separate fire distribution system to said city.

Both of these transfers have been authorized this day by Decisions No. <u>42675</u> and No. <u>42677</u>. Under the circumstances, this investigation is no longer necessary and should be dismissed. Now, therefore.
