FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission by Decision No. 43432, dated October 25, 1949, authorizes Associated Freight Lines to issue and sell, on or before June 30, 1950, one thousand (1,000) shares of its capital stock. The opinion in that decision recites that the stock will be sold to the following:

San Francisco Warehouse Company	one-ninth
Henry F. Hiller, of San Francisco Ware- house Company	one-ninth
Lloyd Swayne, of San Francisco Ware- house Company	one-ninth

Applicant advises the Commission in its supplemental application that Edgar S. Stanley, an individual, is operating a public utility warehouse. To remove any doubt as to his right to acquire one-third of said shares of stock, applicant asks the

Commission to authorize him to acquire the same.

The Commission has considered applicant's request and believes that it should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph four of the order in Decision No. 43432, dated October 25, 1949, reading:

"4. San Francisco Warehouse Company may acquire one-ninth of the stock which Associated Freight Lines is herein authorized to issue and sell."

be, and the same is hereby, amended to read:

4. San Francisco Warehouse Company may acquire one-ninth and Edgar S. Stanley one-third of the stock which Associated Freight Lines is herein authorized to issue and sell.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority granted by this first supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
