ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant is a highway common carrier operating between Sacramento, on the one hand, and Indian Flat and Downieville and intermediate points, on the other hand, and locally between Indian Flat and Downieville. By this application, filed August 22, 1949, he sought relief from filing the C.O.D. (collect on delivery) bond required by General Order No. 84B. He subsequently informed the Commission in writing that he did not desire to handle C.O.D. shipments. The general order provides that common carriers which do not wish to handle such shipments may publish provisions in their tariffs to the effect that the service is not furnished. The relief originally sought is no longer desired or necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed.
