O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct Rosemead Boulevard (State Highway, Route 168) at separated grades under the tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company's San Bernardino line in Los Angeles County, at the location as shown by the maps attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6T-11.00-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and a copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing, approved by Pacific Electric Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

During the construction period, applicant is authorized to construct temporary detour roads at grade over these tracks. in accordance with the plan described in the application, said crossings to be protected by the existing crossing signals located

at the grade crossing of Rosemead Boulevard. Upon completion of the separation as authorized herein, and upon its being opened to public use and travel, these temporary crossings, as well as the existing grade crossing of Rosemead Boulevard (Crossing No. 6T-11.00), shall be abandoned and effectively barricaded to public use and travel.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
