O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct Truman Avenue (State Highway Route 213) at grade across a transfer track of Southern Pacific Company's Valley line in the City of San Fernando, Los Angeles County, at the location as shown by the map (Exhibit "A") attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-462.09-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 3 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs, General Order No. 75-B. No train, engine, motor, or car shall be operated over said crossing unless said train, engine, motor, or car

shall be first brought to a stop and traffic on the highway protected by a member of the train crew, or other competent employee, acting as flagman.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or, if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
