## O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company are authorized to construct a spur track at grade across the intersection of Quint Street and Fairfax Avenue in San Francisco, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2SF-2.38. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the intersection now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicants shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicants shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
