SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, by Decision No. 43336, dated September 27, 1949, in this proceeding, (1) Salvador Gomez, Robert D. Rueda and Perfecto Elizondo, doing business as United Produce Company and hereinafter called respondents, were directed to cease and desist from failing or refusing to assess and collect transportation charges and from failing or refusing to compile and maintain records on shipping documents in any manner whatsoever other than as authorized by the provisions of the Commission's Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 8, supplements thereto and reissues thereof, and (2) Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 54-3195 heretofore granted to respondents was ordered suspended for a period of thirty (30) days from and after the effective date of said decision;

WHEREAS, respondents on October 13, 1949, filed a petition for rehearing respecting said decision;

WHEREAS, by order, dated December 13, 1949, said petition for rehearing was granted for the limited purpose of determining whether the period during which the radial highway common carrier permit granted to respondents was ordered suspended should be modified or amended; and

WHEREAS, respondents on January 3, 1950, filed a petition seeking to withdraw their petition for rehearing. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That the order granting rehearing, dated December 13, 1949, in this proceeding be and it is hereby rescinded and set aside.
- (2) That in all respects the order in Decision No.

 43336, dated September 27, 1949, shall be in full force and effect.

 This supplemental order shall become effective twenty
