ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across 53rd Street in Emeryville, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. A-7.47-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry to be served, General Electric Supply Corporation, requires immediate completion of said track in order to

facilitate construction of its new warehouse. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
