ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Southern Pacific Company, Pacific Electric Railway Company, Pacific Motor Trucking Company, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company and Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company seek an order exempting from the provisions of General Order 84B some 74 contract draymen designated in the application and other contract draymen who may perform service exclusively for one or more of the applicants in the future.

Applicants do not seek any authorization for themselves. The carriers for whom the relief is sought have not joined in the application, nor does the application show the intent or desire of the parties for whom the relief is sought. For these reasons the application should be dismissed. Dismissal of the application will not in any way prejudice the rights of any of the contract draymen to seek the same relief in their own behalf.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
