ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Southern California Freight Lines seeks an order exempting from the provisions of General Order 84B some 5+ subhaulers designated in the application and other subhaulers who may perform service exclusively for applicant in the future.

Applicant does not seek any authorization for itself. The carriers for whom the relief is sought have not joined in the application, nor does the application show the intent or desire of the parties for whom the relief is sought. For these reasons the application should be dismissed. Dismissal of the application will not in any way prejudice the rights of any of the subhaulers to seek the same relief in their own behalf.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
