ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, asks for authority to carry out the terms and conditions of a written agreement, dated December 19, 1949, with H. E. West and John Fossett, a limited partnership, doing business as Placerville Lumber Company, for the temporary delivery and sale of surplus water from its El Dorado Canal on an accommodation basis for the operation of a lumber mill located at Fresh Pond, El Dorado County. Water deliveries are not to exceed a flow of twenty (20) miner's inches and the rate to be paid for the water is two dollars (\$2) per miner's inch day. The agreement is effective for a one-year period from January 1, 1950, to January 1, 1951, and is similar to the one-year agreements entered into by and between the two parties since October 31, 1945.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant and being of the opinion that the application should be granted, that

a public hearing is not necessary, and good cause appearing; now therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the written agreement, dated December 19, 1949, with H. E. West and John Fossett, a limited partnership, doing business as Placerville Lumber Company, a copy of said agreement being attached to the application as Exhibit A and made a part hereof by reference.
2. Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, shall file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the effective date of this order, two certified copies of the agreement as consummated, together with a statement of the date on which the agreement is deemed to have become effective.
3. Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, shall notify this Commission of the date of termination of said agreement within thirty (30) days thereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
